## ***IBM InfoSphere Data Replication***

- One product that includes multiple replication and change capture technologies
  - Q Replication (High volume, low latency, DB2 to DB2)
  - Event Publishing (capture changes in DB2 and use messaging to inform applications)
  - SQL Replication (capture once in DB2 and send to many targets)
  - Change Data Capture (heterogeneous replication for the enterprise)
- Credit is given for the components of IIDR that you already own
  - IIDR pricing is half of purchasing all 4 of these technologies independently

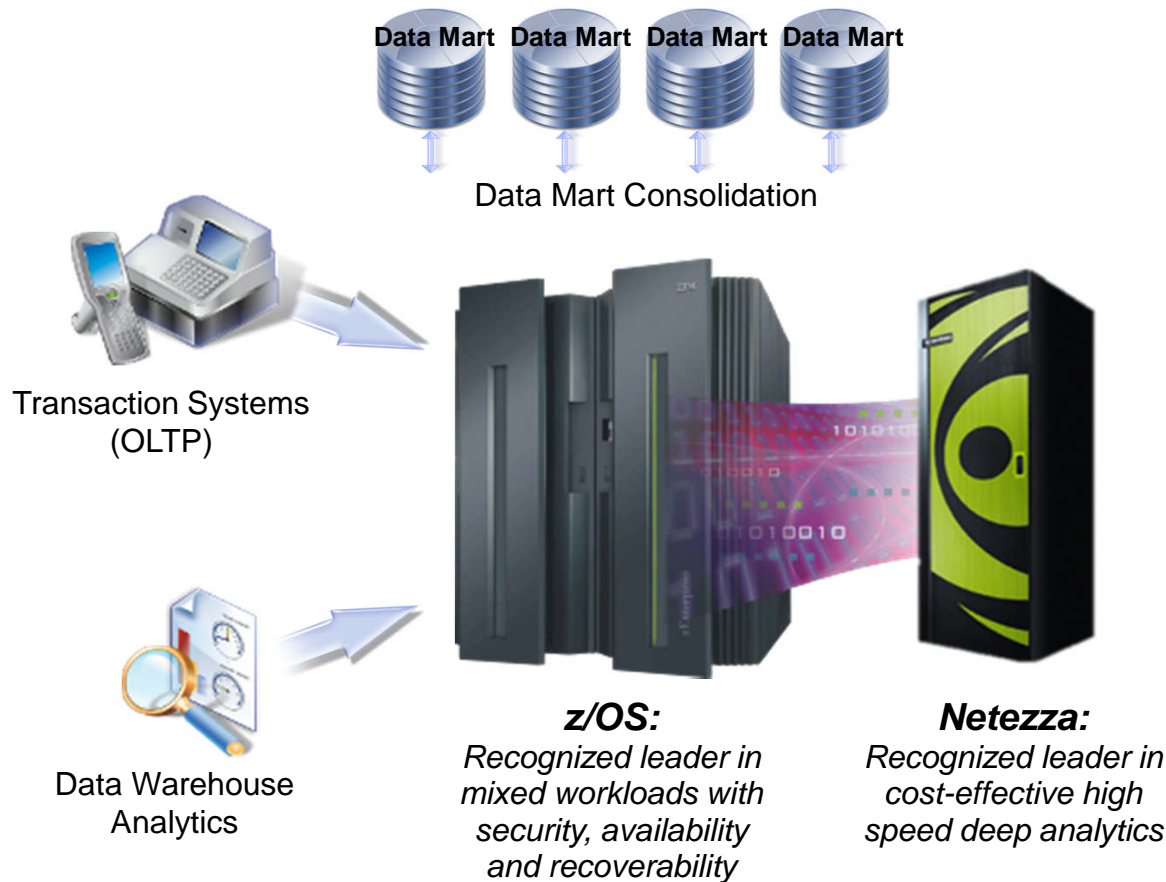
